Conditional registration of series "O" shares of the BNP Paribas Bank Polska SA

Legal grounds: Article 34, section 1, item 1 of the Minister of Finance Ordinance dated 19 February 2009 regarding current and periodical information disclosed by issuers of securities and conditions for recognizing as equivalent information required by the laws of a non-member state (Journal of Laws of 2014, item 133)

The Board of Executives of BNP Paribas Bank Polska SA (the "Bank") hereby informs that on 6 June 2014 the Board of Executives of the National Depository for Securities (the "NDS") by resolution no. 532/14 resolved to register 5,026,539 series O ordinary bearer shares of the Bank with a nominal value of PLN 45.46 each (the "Series O Shares") in the NDS and assign the code PLPPAB000011 thereto, under the condition that the company operating the regulated market adopts a decision to introduce Series O Shares to trading on the same regulated market on which the Bank's other shares marked with the code PLPPAB000011 have been introduced.

The registration of the Series O Shares will take place in connection with the closing of the accounts maintained for the rights to Series O Shares, marked with the code PLPPAB000201, within three days from the date when NDS receives a decision of the company operating the regulated market to introduce Series O Shares to trading on the regulated market but no earlier than the date stated in that decision as a date of introduction of Series O Shares to trading on this market.
