Monika Kaczorek graduated from the Institute of Applied Linguistics at Warsaw University. She completed postgraduate Marketing and Market Analysis studies at Warsaw School of Economics and Business Psychology for Managers at Kozminski University. She qualified as a statutory auditor in 2001.

In the years 1994-2020 she worked for the Mazars Group - an international audit and advisory network. In 2005 she became Partner and Vice-President of the Board of Mazars Audyt. She headed audit practice and was a leader of quality and risk management (internal audit, risk and quality control management of the Mazars network in Poland). She managed a number of teams auditing standalone and consolidated financial statements, including those of financial institutions, entities listed on the Stock Exchange and providing other assurance and advisory services. She was a member of the Mazars International IFRS Task Force and quality control teams in the Mazars Group. She has a long-term experience in auditing standalone and consolidated financial statements, coordinating assurance and advisory work, supervising international strategic projects such as mergers, acquisitions, due diligence, IPO processes.

In the years 2015-2023 she was a member of the National Council of Statutory Auditors and in the years 2019-2023 she served as a Deputy President of the National Council of Statutory Auditors. Since 2021 she has been an independent member of the Supervisory Board and since 2023 a Chair of the Audit Committee of the TUiR Unum Życie S.A. insurance company. She is a member of the Council of the Reporting Standards Foundation of the Listed Companies Association and a member of the jury of the "Best Annual Report" competition. She is also engaged in conducting projects and trainings related to ESEF, ESG and optimisation of presentation of financial statements of listed companies to ensure compliance with IFRS and usefulness for stakeholders.
